1. GLORY DAYS FUNDRAISER

FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, when you dine at a Glory Days Grill, the restaurant will contribute 10% of your total food purchases to the Woodson H. S. Choral Dept. Bring your neighbors, friends, and relatives, because the 10% applies to the total food bill. Simply ask your server for a copy of your guest check, (not credit card receipt), and drop in in the box marked "Glory Days Grill Fundraiser" in the Chorus Room. Questions? 2. GREAT LAKES SCRIP ORDERS

The next scrip order will be placed on April 15th. Orders must be to me no later than 6:00 PM along with your check. PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THIS IS THE LAST ORDER THAT WILL BE CREDITED TO THE EUROPE TRIP ACCOUNT. There will be orders placed in May and June but fundraising credits earned from those orders will be credited towards the next spring trip. The May order will be placed on May 13th and the next Europe payment is due May 15th. As you can see, there is not enough time to process the orders and credits prior to the payment due date. So, if you are thinking about placing a large order, plan for it sooner than later. Also, look on the GLScrip website -- some vendors have upped their rebates.

3. EUROPE TRIP INFORMATION

The March 15th payment is now passed due. If you have not paid yet, please drop off your payment in the box on my back porch immediately. Do not send it in the mail or leave it in my mailbox. Also, I'm still waiting for insurance forms -- remember, you must fill out a form even if you are not purchasing any additional insurance. I also still need a few full, legal name form some participants -- we cannot book our flights without that information from everyone., this includes adults. Thank you to those of you who have sent in two color copies of your passports. For those of you who are still waiting to receive new passports, please get me those copies as soon as possible. It is very important to get all forms and payments to me as requested in a timely fashion. The tour company requires everything to be sent together. Even missing just one person's forms or information holds up the booking for all the remaining 119 of us. Please be considerate of your fellow travelers.
